In this series of workshops cultural agent Silke Ballath and cultural representative Wiebke Janzen (teacher) invite parents, supporters, teachers, educators and pupils to discuss the value of the library as a learning centre for language and story. In the future, in addition to the core library in the Orange House, there will also be library and media rooms in the Red House and the Yellow House – and perhaps even a mobile library for the schoolyard.
